## TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

All players must be collected on time or if making their own way home to leave immediately after their training session ends to avoid overlapping with and of the other aged groups and our D3 Mens Team for Safeguarding purposes. The Club cannot provide supervision for players U18 after their training session has ended. Late collection due to an emergency must be notified to Lehoma or the Team Manager urgently.
